Reading: Our books for this term are:

Superworm, Owl Babies, The Little Red Hen, Three Little Pigs and The Jolly Christmas Postman. We will also be studying books related to the Great Fire of London as part of our topic. We will do daily phonic lessons using the Sounds Write Programme to develop word reading skills.

Writing: We will be focussing on letter formation and letter size. We will also be focussing on writing sentences using a capital letter and full stop.



Maths: Our key focus in Maths this term is place value addition and subtraction and 2D and 3D shapes. We will be working with numbers to 20. Number formation and using practical equipment will be developed.
