We aim to stick to timetables, but occasionally there may be changes for a variety of reasons.

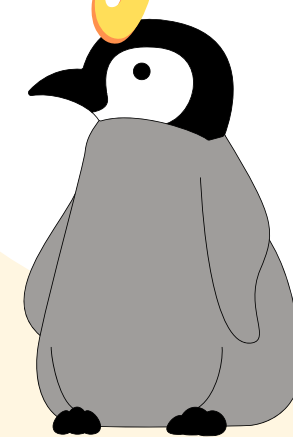

Our week is so busy that we cannot fit in every subject. We block up our Art and DT lessons so that we can create quality work over a number of themed days. We will also do handwriting practise and maths fluency daily.

Homework

Each Wednesday, children will be set Maths and English tasks. They will also have some topic related tasks throughout the term. Children are also expected to read their phonic book daily and bring it into school every day. Please use logins for Numbots and Spelling Frame for additional practise in number and tricky words or sounds learnt.





Reading: Our books for this term are: Geronimo, Immi, Walking Through the Jungle, Rumble in the Jungle, The Ugly Duckling, Thumbelina and Smelly Jelly Smelly Fish. We will also be studying non-fiction books related to animals topic. We will do daily phonic lessons using the Sounds Write Programme to develop word reading skills.

Writing: We will be focussing on writing sentences more independently, using our phonic knowledge and using punctuation correctly.

Maths: Our key focus in Maths this term is place value within 50, addition and subtraction. length, height and mass. Number formation and using practical equipment will be developed.



Science

In Science we will be learning about changes in the seasons and animals including humans

History

In History we will be learning about our own timeline

Computing

In Computing we will be learning IT skills to create stories and data handling

Art

In Art we will be developing and learning new painting techniques

PE

In PE we will be learning to develop skills in dance

Geography

In Geography we will be learning mapping skills through the UK and British Isles
